The Up To Speed **photojournalism** course leads to an NCTJ qualification and is taught over two twelve-week terms.

The first term runs from Tuesday to Friday at Up To Speed's training centre in the Daily Echo, Bournemouth.

In this time you will learn **essential law for photographers** and **news writing** as well as taking the key course in **photographic knowledge**, covering both stills and video work. You will sit NCTJ exams in all three subjects at the end of the term.



In the second term you will study for a further NCTJ exam in **photographic practice** while working on assignments in photography, documentary or photojournalism. At the end of the term you will submit a portfolio of work for assessment.



The associate lecturer in charge of the Up To Speed photojournalism course is a working national press photographer with extensive contacts and experience in news and features.

The course is open to graduates, career-changers and school leavers. You must be able to demonstrate an aptitude and commitment to photography and photojournalism.
